- Obtaining resources to support Teaching Reading and Writing Series.


Our initiatives include

- Ensure that a whole school approach to the teaching of reading and writing is supported by Teaching Reading and Writing Series.
- Engage and educate parents and caregivers in the skills of reading and writing to support the school's approach.
